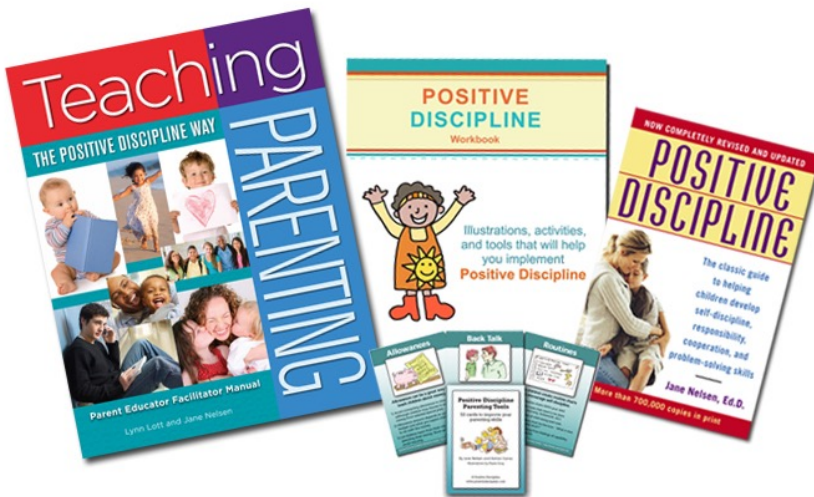


Teaching Parenting
